# Album 8. Frank Dawson Bliley Photo Album 2 1922–1939 Scanned: September 2015

## Introduction

This album is unique, as it appears to be an incomplete project. There is neither rhyme nor reason to the organization and the album may have been a holding place for some miscellaneous photos. There were a handful of loose photos which fortunately for us, many had captions.



## About the Album

The album was found in the family archives in Boulder with the pages broken from the binding. *As a result, the exact order of the pages is unknown* and they were scanned in a thoughtful sequence that later was discovered to be imperfect. Thankfully, many photographs and pages are captioned on the back. I placed small labels on each sheet and identified the front and back of each. The label contains an abbreviated album number, in this case 8, of the ten albums found and scanned in 2015.

Each page has a sticker on it identifying it as Album 8, page/sheet sheet number and front or rear side. For example: "Bliley, F. Dawson - Album 2 1922-39 – Page 01-Rear-P3-2200.jpg" = Album 2's 10th sheet rear. All are in TIFF format whose content can be search by the Macintosh Finder.



All pages were scanned at a fairly high resolution of 1,200 ppi. Individual photos were chosen for higher-resolution scans at 2,200 ppi. Files names with "Captions" at the end are full-page scans with the photos reversed to reveal the original captions on the photo's backs.

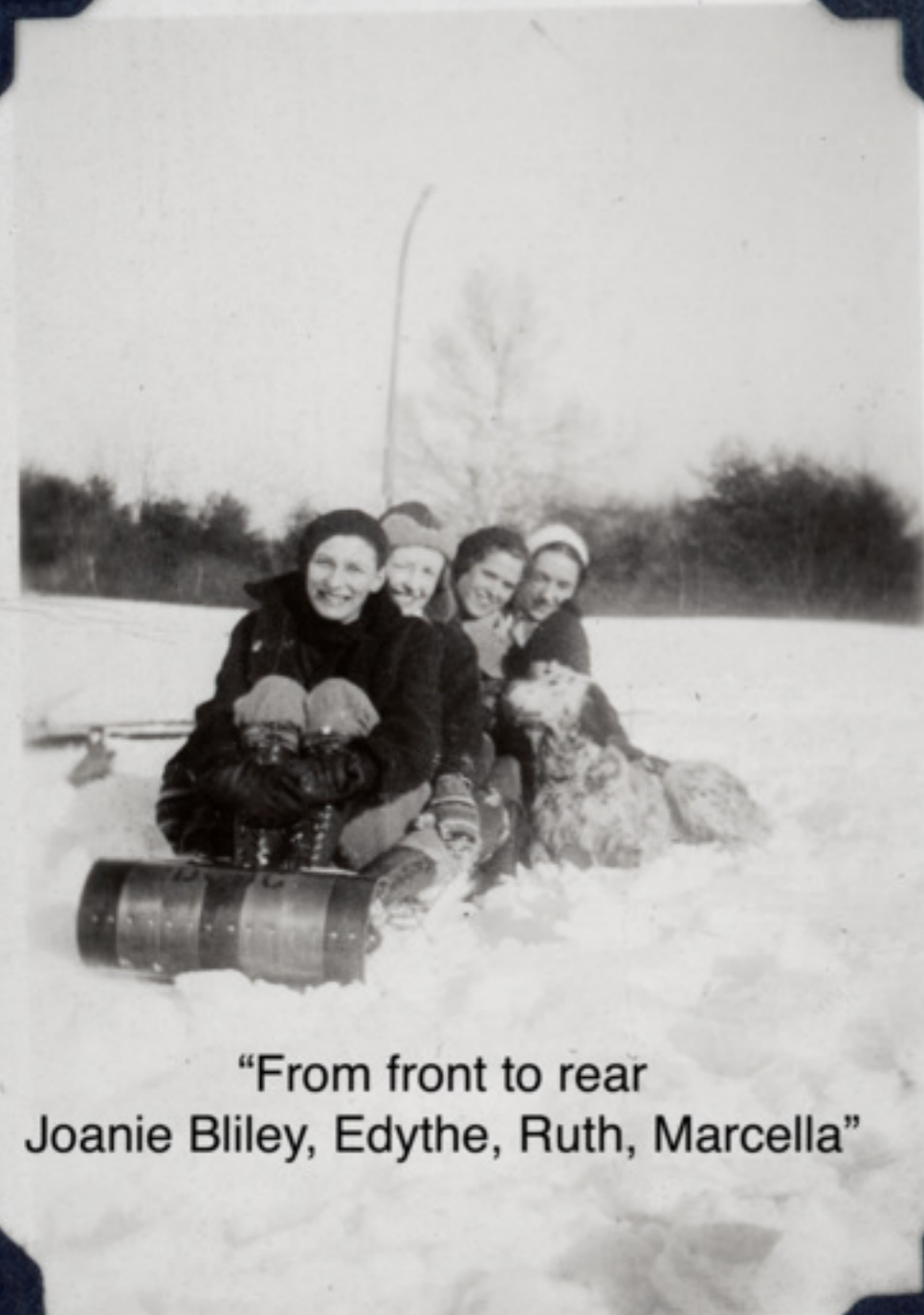

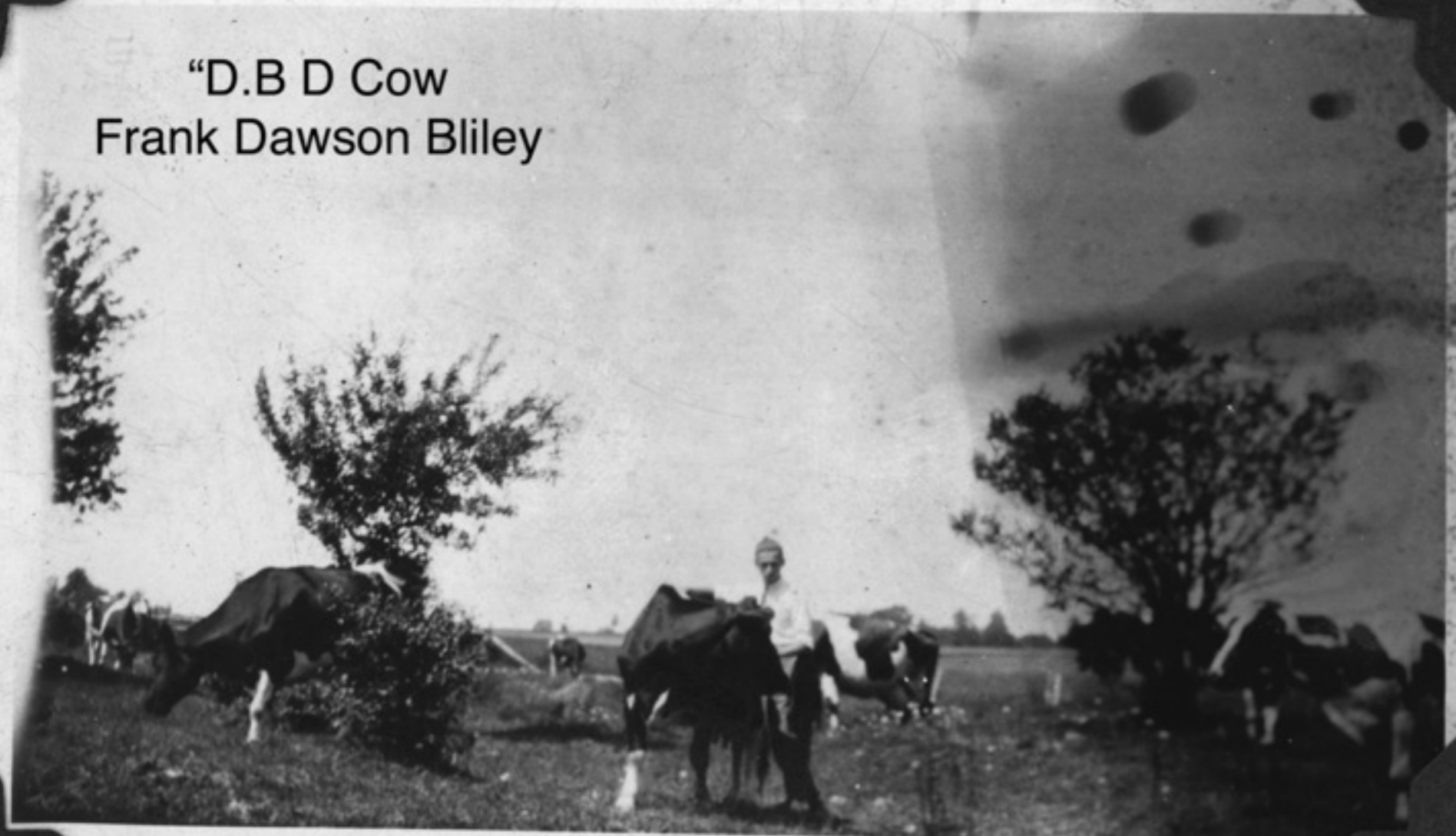

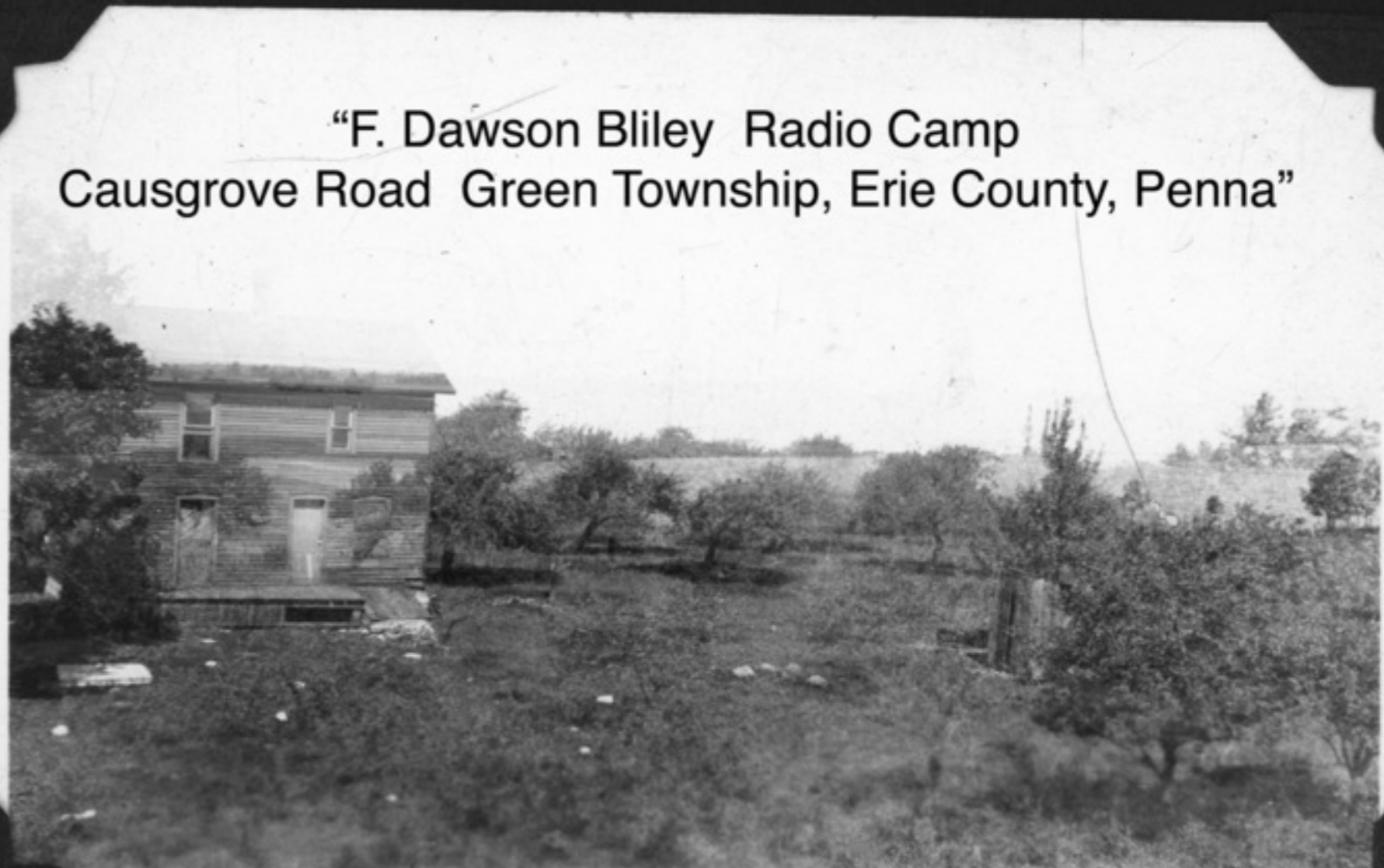
