DISCOVERING A FAMILY JEWEL!


- Visited cousin Jim, in Erie, PA

WHAT IS SPECIAL ABOUT THE ALBUM?

- 75 mounted photos
- Five generations in photos
- Photos from 1860s through 1930s
- In chronological order
- All people named-most with relationship to her
- Personal comments for some people
- Most photos from large negatives (contact prints)
- No living relatives in photos





WHAT DO I DO WITH IT NOW?


- 1. Capture the images before I had to give it back.










WINDOW AUTORUN

OBJECTIVES

- Preserve the photos through electronic scans
- Assure computer platform independence
- Maximize long-term file format viability
- Distribute to immediate family members







OBJECTIVES

- Place in historical context
 - Personal background on grandmother
 - Other family history projects she had done
 - How the album was "discovered"
 - My relationship to my grandmother and the album







- PHILOSOPHICAL & PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS
 - Will the digital album provide the viewer with the same experience as paper?
 - What data formats will survive for 10 years?
 - Will there anyone convert the resources into as yet unknown data formats?
 - How many current platforms can be supported?







- PHILOSOPHICAL & PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS
 - Should the scans include...
 - Only the photos?
 - Photos and handwritten captions?
 - Should you include photos of living relatives?
 - Should the photos be touched-up?







- PHILOSOPHICAL & PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS
 - Should the CD be seen as...
 - genealogy database?
 - entertainment?
 - historical resource?
 - just a photo album?







- PHILOSOPHICAL & PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS
 - Copyrights?
 - Protection from commercial use
 - Encourage personal use
 - Encourage historical groups use







- PHILOSOPHICAL & PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS
 - Can the CDs be reliably and economically reproduced?
 - Should CDs be...
 - Given away?
 - Sold at a profit?
 - Sold at cost?







- PHILOSOPHICAL & PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS
 - Will anyone else really be interested in this work?
 - Immediate family
 - Extended family
 - Non-family members
 - Am I willing to make a serious commitment in time and energy to this project?







PHILOSOPHICAL & **PRACTICAL** CONSIDERATIONS

- Q. Will the digital album provide the viewer with the same experience as paper?
- A. No. But, the digital album makes it practical and safe to share it with hundreds or thousands of people.







PHILOSOPHICAL & PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS

Q. What data formats will survive for 10 years?

A. In my opnion...

HTML: No TIFF: Yes

JPEG: Yes GIF: No

PDF: Yes

Photoshop Native (.PSD): Maybe







PDF (PORTABLE DOCUMENT FORMAT)

- Embraced by U.S. Government
- Open standard that will evolve independently of any vendor
- More elegant & controllable presentation possible that in HTML
- Controllable presentation
- Text is searchable and indexable






PDF (PORTABLE DOCUMENT FORMAT)

- Single source (PDF file) for all materials—text and images
- Uniform presentation in five computer operating systems










VIRTUAL COVER

Hotlinks to full page views










CAPTIONS


FULL-PAGE VIEW

Full Pages (150 dpi)


Individual Photos (300-600 dpi)

DATA FILE FORMAT' OBJECTIVES

- Provide all images in mixture of common formats—a buckshot approach
 - PDF (.PDF)
 - JPEG (.JPG)
 - TIFF (.TIF)
 - Photoshop native (.PSD)







DATA FILE FORMAT' OBJECTIVES

- Hypertext Markup Language (HTML)
 - Readable on every current computer...
 with some risk
 - HTML is evolving in a competitive environment
 - OK for today, but not likely to be compatible in 10 years







Adobe Photoshop LE

- San Images
- Edit (Color Correction & Touch-up)
- Change Resolution

MS Word

- Prepare various text based material







PhotoPage

- Photo scrapbooks
- Places the thumbnails in an HTML page with hyperlinks to full-sized images.
- Automatically creates thumbnails in GIF & JPEG
- Rotation and cropping tools







- Adobe PageMill
 - HTML layout program
 - Based-browser viewing of album on CD-ROM
 - Development of Web site.
- Browser Call (Autorun Application)
 - Launches user browser on CD insertion
 - Small freeware application







- Adobe Acrobat Suite
 - Create PDF files from PageMaker and add links, bookmarks and notes to finished PDF files.
- Toast (Mac)/ Easy CD Creater (Windows)
 - CD Authoring ("burning")
 - ISO 9660 Data Format (Mac/Unix/Windows)

ALTERNATE TOOLS AND TECHNIQUES?

- Export from genealogy database programs in HTML and JPEG
- Less ambitious form with a more limited scope
